

## Use this handy CHECKLIST to help you plan for your next vacation!

<u>RESEARCH</u>
Destination and local weather
Local tourist attractions - available discount coupons; dates and hours of operation
Duty-free allowances
Airline carry-on restrictions - toiletry items; luggage size, weight, number of pieces and additiona charges; regulations for pets
Services of travel agent
Insurance company requirements - How frequently do they require your home to be checked while you are away?
RESERVATIONS
Flight/Train/Bus
Ground Transportation - to/from airport, train station, bus station
Accommodations - hotel, resort, bed & breakfast
Rental car, bicycles, scooters, etc.
Tourist attractions, ski lessons, scuba diving, etc.
Pets - Kennel
INTERNATIONAL / OUT-OF-PROVINCE or STATE TRAVEL
Passport/visa – apply or renew – Many countries will not allow entry if your passport expires 3–6 months prior to your travel date.
Prepaid calling card and international dialling instructions
Notify credit card company/bank that you will be travelling out of the country to avoid card cancellation.

Camera, film, memory cards, batteries, video camera, tapes

## **AT HOME**

Possible arrangements to be made:
Neighbour/friend/family – to check home, including refrigerator, freezer and hot water tank
House sitter
Mail pick-up - have post office hold or redirect
Newspaper - cancel
Lights – put on timers
Water - turn off water
Grass – cut
Garden - water and weed
Snow – shovel
Suggested tasks prior to departure:
Hot water tank - turn to vacation setting
Prevent potential water problems - shut off automatic washer taps
Prevent potential electrical problems – in case of power outage/possible storm damage, unpluge electronics – television, computer, etc.
Leave these items at home:
Emergency contact information
Trip itinerary
Copy of passport/visa - in case of loss or theft
Record of credit cards and traveller's cheques numbers
